last Will and Testament of Hannah Woolley deceased
was produced in court & proven by the oath of
James Shaggs who also swore that Jeremiah Shaggs
whose name is subscribed as a witness to said Will
has departed this life & that his signature is in
the hand writing of said deceased Shaggs. It
was also proven to be the last Will and Testament
by the oath of Joseph Popper whose name is
not subscribed as a witness but was present
at the time said Will was acknowledged. And
the same was ordered to be recorded.

A Will

In the name of God amen I Thomas
Gilliland of Warden County being of perfect
health and memory thanks be given unto
God calling to mind the mortality of my
Body and knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make and Ordain
this my last Will and Testament that is to
say principally and first of all I give and
Recomend my soul into the hand of all
mighty God that gave it, and my body
I recomment to the Earth to be Buried in
decent Christian burial at the discretion of

my Executors nothing doubting But at the General
resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the
mighty power of God and as touching such worldly
Estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to Bless in
this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner and form

First I give and bequeath to Priscilla my dearly
Beloved wife the one third part of this dwelling
place as long as she lives and all the moveable
property save and except one Horse and saddle
two cows and a feather Bed which I give to my well
Beloved Daughter Sinaith. Next I give to my son
James three hundred and seventy five acres
of land lying and Situate on the waters
of Bear Creek Clay lick fork, To my sons
Hugh and Aaron I give four hundred acres
of Land of the South West End of a nine
hundred acre Survey running fifty poles wider
at the upper end than the lower lying and
situate on the head of Little Clifty and that
to be equally divided between them Both
according to quantity and quality. To my sons
Thomas and William I give the Ballance of the
aforesaid Survey containing five hundred acres
to be equally divided between them according
to quantity and quality. My Daughter Sarah
Gilliland Hannah and Mary Priscilla Rebecca
and Rachael they all have got their shares before
this time. I give and bequeath to my son John
two hundred and fifty acres of Land after my
wifes death, It being the plantation I now live on,

Also it is my Will and desire that if any of my
 aforesaid sons shall die without a law full heir
 the deceased of any of them his share of the land
 shall be given back to the remaining brothers
 and equally divided amongst them. Lastly I
 appoint Patrick Brown and Stephen Rollins
 my Lawful Executors. And I do hereby utterly
 disallow revoke and disannul all and every
 other former Testaments Wills Legacies bequests
 and Executors by me in any way before
 named Willed and bequeathed. Ratifying
 and confirming this and no other to be my
 last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 fifth day of April in the year of our

Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
 Signed sealed and
 Publicly pronounced and Thomas Gilliland sealed
 declared by the said
 Thomas Gilliland as his
 last Will and Testament
 in the presence of us who
 in his presence and in the
 presence of each other have
 hereunto subscribed our names

 ty of this mortal life and being in perfect health &
 sound memory blessed be almighty God for the same
 do make & publish this my last Will & Testament
 in manner and form following to wit, Inpremis
 I order that all my Just Dotts and funeral Expenses
 be paid Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife
 Barbara Roof one third part of all my Estate Real &
 Personal during her natural lifetime & after her decease
 to descend to my youngest son Nicholas Roof Item I
 give & bequeath unto my eldest son Martin Roof the
 plantation on which he formerly lived on containing
 one hundred acres adjoining the farm he now occupies
 to him and his heirs forever Item I give & bequeath
 unto my eldest daughter Catherine Whelstone one
 hundred acres of land adjoining Tobias Hendricks
 on which John Easter now lives out of my five
 hundred acre tract by paying to my daughter
 Elizabeth fifty Dollars out of the same Item I give
 & bequeath unto my son Michael Roof the tract of
 land he now lives on containing two hundred &
 fifty acres more or less to him and his heirs forever
 Item I give & bequeath unto my son in Law William
 Bazant ^{the plantation} on which he now lives containing one
 hundred acres by his paying to my daughter
 Rosanna fifty Dollars to him and his heirs for ever
 Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Susanna
