named Rose with my bed and bedding, I will
to my son John the following negroes viz, Absa-
and Saml with Absa's eldest girl Jane, I will
that my daughter Esther shall have one barrel of
and one dollars cash, with a feather Bed and all her
furniture I will to her three children viz James, Mary
Nancy, W. Cox, and Malinda three negroes viz
Hannah, Ben & Dick, likewise I will to her
rebrace, prove & inheritance that they have
therein in full & possession of their mother
during her life natural and at her decease
James W. Cox to have Hannah, Mary to
have Ben, Malinda to have Dick, I will
that if my my property will exchange
my lawful debts without paying for
the same that my daughter Eliza shall
have share as her sole right and property
I will that at my decease my negro
son and Zeph shall be liberated equally
to the laws of the land and at full liberty
to live where she will choose
I will that my boy of Colours name
