McCallister. Beginning at a small Oak tree on the Bank of the Ohio River near the old Camp Shiloh thence running down with said River ninety five poles to Richard Warfields Corner, thence with said Warfields line South 50° East 300 poles to a large Burr oak, thence North 40° East 30 poles to a stake, thence with a straight line to the Beginning - We also assign to her a negro Boy called Modern and fifty Dollars in money for her dowry in the Slaves Given under our hands the 25th day of May 1837.
