(My) I give and bequeath to my daughter Pemma two negroes namely Amelia and Jane one horse and saddle and one feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever - I give and bequeath to my Robt Eas one hundred acres land lying on the Ohio River adjoining Evans Lambert. Also one negro boy named Phil, one horse and saddle, and one feather Bed and furniture so soon as he becomes of lawful age or marries to him this thing forever

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
