Henderson County Kentucky January 4th 1825

In obedience to the within order from the County Court of Henderson County and directed by Lazarus Powell Charles M Allen and William Williams after first being sworn duly proceeded to allot the late Nancy Braces Power of Asa Turner deceased Estate as follows One Negro Woman named Celine One Negro boy named John One Negro Girl named Louisa as being in part of the Negro property and then proceeded to allot her Power of land including the mansion house as full out beginning at a small Honey Locust & small Walnut thence South 61° to 83° to a State thence South

29° N 10 1/2° to popular dogwood & black Oak thence North 29° East 61° to 83° to two hickories and Oak thence North 29° East 61° to the beginning containing by estimation fifty five acres but the greater part of this fifty five acres being improved land we proceeded to lay off nearly five acres adjoining of woodland as follows Beginning at a Honey Locust and Saplings thence running N 61° West 70 poles to an ash & black gum thence South 29° West eighty poles to a State in said line thence S 61° East 70 poles to two Honey Locust and Elm thence North 29° to 80 poles to the beginning containing by Estimation 90 acres And agreeably to the within Order of the within of this County Court aforesaid we then proceeded to settle with William P. Pol the dowry of Asa Turner deceased and upon a settlement with said Pol we find from the evidence and vouchers received that he William P. Pol doth as aforesaid indebted to the Estate of Asa Turner deceased One Hundred and Sixty eight Dollars & forty nine cents and upon an examination of his papers we find that Richard M Bruce the husband of said Nancy Braces became indebted to the children in their American (Robert Smith) One Hundred and eighty Dollars Seventeen & one hundred cents In Witness Whereof we as named above have hereunto set our hands this day and date above

Robert Church of Henderson County Kentucky being weak
in body but of sound mind and knowing the uncertainty of
human life do hereby make Constable & Ordain this my last
Will & Testament in the following form and manner (To wit)

1st My Will is that all my just Estate of every description that I do possess
2^d Having given to my son Rhenshaw Church five hundred and
fifty Dollars & twenty two Cents here before due to my son Samuel
Church three hundred & twenty two Dollars my Will is
that my Executor pay to Samuel Church One hundred
Dollars more out of my personal Estate not otherwise devised
I further Will to my two sons Rhenshaw Church & Samuel
Church two negro Slaves Jeph & Isaac to be equally divided
between them

3rd Having given my Daughter Elizabeth Hope One negro Slave
here before named Matilda as her real property my Will is
that my Daughter Elizabeth Hope shall have One hundred & twenty
more paid her by my Executor to be raised out of my personal
estate, not otherwise devised

4th My Will is that my land I now reside on shall be
remain undivided between my children here after named
(to wit) Richard Church, Susanna Floyd, Mary Church
Robert Church, Elam Church, Masora Church, Edward
Church, James Church, & Ann Church for the Space of
five years from the date of this Will in order that all my
Children last mentioned should continue together & have a
home that they may resort to for the Space of five years
at which time my Will is that my land above mentioned
should be equally with the following Slaves which
is to remain on the land of or said for the Space of
five years also (to wit) Nelson, George, Jimmy

My John Smoly, between Richard Church, Masora
Floyd, Mary Church, Rhenshaw Church, Elam Church, Masora
Church, Edward Church, James Church, & Ann Church
equally with all them men and here after which said Slaves
last mentioned are to be employed for the maintenance
of my Children last named above

5th Whereas I have given my Daughter Susanna Floyd
three hundred Dollars here before my Will is that the
said three hundred Dollars should be charged to her
at the division as a part of her legacy named in my Will

6th My Will is that Mary Church, Robert Church, Elam
Church, Masora Church, Edward Church, James Church,
& Ann Church shall have each One third of the interest

of Cow and Calf in addition to what I have given them
here before as their own property whenever they may
think proper to take them out of my personal Estate

Also my Will is that Masora Church, Elam Church,
Edward Church, James Church, & Ann Church shall
have each of them a good Saddle given them to be
paid for out of my Estate whenever they may think proper
to call for them in addition to what I have here before given
them

7th My Will is that Edward Church, James Church,
& Ann Church should be sent to School until they receive
a good English Education which is to be paid for out
of my personal Estate property

8th My Will is that if any of my Children should die
before they marry or arrive to the age of twenty One years
that their Estate should devolve to the surviving legacies
Except Rhenshaw Church, Samuel Church, & Elizabeth

9th My Will is that all my personal Estate of every
description not here before devised shall be sold &
equally divided between Richard Church, Susanna
Floyd, Mary Church, Robert Church, Elam Church,
Masora Church, Edward Church, James Church,
& Ann Church

10th My Will is that Robert Church, Elam Church,
Edward Church, & James Church should
