 the enjoyment of their freedom
 Lastly I constitute and appoint Norwalk I sheweth James
 Marshall James Leitchman and Samuel C. Heatham exe-
 cutors to this my last will and Testament

 their heirs & assigns forever all that tract of land, number
 which was purchased from different persons which tract of
 land contains two thousand two hundred & twenty seven acres to
 be equally divided between them it is however my will & desire
 and the devise herein made are subject to this condition that in
 case any of the land herein devised should be recovered from the
 devisees by superior adverse title then in that case the devisees so
 excluded from their land shall receive from each of the others devisees
 such sums or sum of money as shall be equivalent to the value of
 the land so lost that is to say that each devisee is to be bound
 for his proportion of the value of the said land at the time of my
 death I give & devise to my Daughter Elizabeth H. Hopkins & Mar-
 tha H. Hopkins their heirs & assigns forever all that tract parcel
 or lot of land numbered fourteen in the Henderson Co Grant
 in the County of Henderson containing one thousand four hundred
 and six & a half acres being the land sold & conveyed to me by
 the said Smith to be equally divided between my Daughters
 Elizabeth & Martha I give & devise to my Men's daughter mar-
