 The last will and Testament of John Inguay of Henderson County State of Kentucky do. John Inguay considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory (Blessed be almighty god for the same) Do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following That is to say First I give and bequeath unto my house keeper Jimima Pashan all my land where I now at present live situate lying and being in Henderson County State of Kentucky together with all my other Freehold Estate whatsoever to hold during her natural life also one negro girl named Priscilla after paying my funeral expenses and other just debts and due her death the land and a negro girl named Priscilla with the residue of the freehold estate then to be divided equally between her heirs now living I gave and bequeath unto her eldest son a Negro man named Bob and my rifle gun and saddle also one hundred Dollars to be taken out of his mother's estate at her death meaning the estate that is to

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 be divided left to her in this will exclusively to her equal portions with the rest of the children I gave and bequeath unto her eldest daughter a negro man named George and one hundred Dollars to be taken out of the Estate left her mother exclusively to her equal portions also one feather bed I gave and bequeath unto her son Henry and a negro man named Peter I gave and bequeath unto her son John one negro man named William I gave and bequeath unto her daughter Sannanah a half Quarter Section of land containing eight acres lying in Marick County State of Indiana is a white negro woman named Sela and one feather bed I gave and bequeath unto my brother Fugway one Dollar I gave and bequeath unto my sister Kodesh Vanhook one Dollar I gave and bequeath unto my brother Joseph Inguay two one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto this State five one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto George Bell five one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto my brother Henry Inguay five one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto John B. Clothling five one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto Thomas B. Clothling five one Dollar each I gave and bequeath unto my wife I have her debts set my hands and seal this 12th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty second
