It is my will and desire that all my just Debts be paid by my Executors and Executor hereinafter named. 2^d I Give and bequeath all my Estate both the real and personal after the payment of my just Debts, to my wife Johannah for & during her natural life. 3^d It is my will and desire that all my Estate both the real and personal after the death of my said wife Johannah be equally divided between my Sister Jane Holmden & living and my two daughters Jane Holmden and Mary Holmden. 4th If any of said Sister Jane Holmden shall not be living at the death of my wife Johannah that the same be legally divided between my two Daughters aforesaid. I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Johannah Executor, and Samuel H. Hamman and Executor of this my last will and Testament. It is my desire that no sale be made of personal Estate unless by my said Executor and Executor shall do as it may be necessary or expedient for the purpose of paying my Debts or otherwise if they think proper.
