and Guardians in said County, do Certify, that the foregoing true & correct settlement of the accounts of John G. Holloway guardian of Henry Lyne orphan, was returned to the Court at the January term 1839 & finished this 26th day of January 1839 of which have a place the said Henry Lyne and James & Rankin his present guardians & due notice according to law. And we do further Certify that all the accounts & vouchers mentioned & referred to in the above account ~~and~~ not otherwise proven, were sworn to before us by the said John G. Holloway, who stated upon his oath, that said accounts & vouchers & the items therein contain are of his own knowledge true and correct. From which said account it appears, that there remains in the hands of said Holloway due to the said Henry Lyne the sum of \$491.25 cents - We further state that said Holloway has in his hands two notes on Philip Sheehy for \$100 each taken for the rent of the land belonging to Henry & James Lyne due the 1st day of Feb^y 1840 & the other due the first day of February 1841. One of which, or one half of both belongs to the said Henry Lyne & said Holloway is to transfer the same to the present guardian of said Henry - And we would further state that all the rent above mentioned for the year 1838 was due the 1st day of January 1839 and many or most of the notes or bonds taken therefor are unpaid all which is respectfully submitted to the most honorable Justices of the Henderson County Court - Given under our hands as Commissioners as aforesaid this 26th day of January 1839
