B. Green the residue of his Slaves Mellic (23) Humphrey (23) China (23) Rachel (14) Lewis (13) Charles (10) Mary (9) Melcher (7) Thornton (5) Henry (3) William & Martha Moore (27) Anne (3) Amstead (4) Jackson (2) Martha B. month. Rice (24) Judith (7) John (2) which were all the Slaves known to us and which were allotted in families as nearly as we could so as to give the Widow one third part of the value of said Slaves and no lands being known to us as the property of the said G. B. Green no allotment thereof was made by us as which is respectfully reported to the Court.
