" Luke Towler died in the year 1837, and the family
 consisting of Mr Towler, Edwards, Elizabeth, James and
 B. F. Towler, have lived together ever since, until the recent
 marriage of Miss Towler to Mr. Whelaney, it has therefore been
 thought reasonable to allow Mr. Towler the sum of \$300.
 for the boarding and other incidental charges being an average
 allowance of \$60. for five years from 1828 to 1832. both
 inclusive, vouchers to the amount of \$600. or upwards
 have been rejected, it not being deemed proper to make
 the estate liable for Mr. Towler's individual debts tho'
 a portion of these debts were no doubt contracted for the benefit of the family.
 By this sum for Boarding, Clothing and other incidental
 expenses of the family for five years as above stated. 300 00
 Add 839 paid by B. Green in 1817 receipt in Clerk's Office. 29 00
 (In this settlement the sum of \$96.70 is paid by B. Green tho'
 Edward Towler, is rejected, the receipt in Clerk's Office in
 suit of J. B. Green vs. Estate as it is believed this sum was paid
 by Crediting Luke Towler's acc^t with Edward Towler.) \$1430.94

From the above settlement it appears that there is due to Martha
 Towler administratrix of Luke Towler deceased the sum of \$101.88^{1/2}
 etc. Mr. Towler will however be liable for \$72. for Jack's hire
 in 1832. to Robert B. Strickley if recovered, that sum being
 now unpaid, and if not, for a reasonable hire for Jack, for
 the time she kept him after his return.
