I Mary Powell of the County of Henderson and State of Kentucky being now in health but of limited mind and memory and taking into consideration the uncertainty of life do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Will by me heretofore made, viz. 1st

1st My Will is that my funeral expences and just debts be paid out of my Estate.

2nd I give and bequeath to William P. Harrington for the use and benefit of my daughter Sarah Harrington and her children One hundred and ten acres of land in Henderson County which I bought of Alfred H. Powell also all my stock of cattle and hogs and crop of corn and tobacco together with all my property of any description. And it is my will that said William P. Harrington hold the above property in trust for the sole and use and benefit of my said daughter Sarah Harrington during her natural life and at her death the same or the residue if any remaining be equally divided amongst her children.

Lastly I do hereby appoint William Knight Powell executor of this my last Will and Testament and I desire that there shall be no lack of my personal property until the payment of my debts requires it to the contrary whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 31st day of October 1824.

In the Name of God Amen. I David L. Butler of the County of Henderson and State of Kentucky being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with I give and bequeath the same in manner following, that is to say

I desire that all the perishable part of my Estate be immediately sold after my decease and out of the money arising therefrom all my just debts and funeral expences be paid. Should there remain any part of my property prove insufficient for the above purposes then I desire that my Executor hereafter named may sell my land lying in Henderson County on the Ohio River and out of the money arising therefrom pay and satisfy back of my just debts as shall remain unpaid out of the perishable part of my Estate.

After the payment of my debts and funeral expences I give to my Brothers William L. Butler and Henry L. Butler all my Estate to be divided equally between them but on a^c to be enjoyed by them forever. Now lastly I do hereby constitute my friends William Soper and Alfred Hill Executors of my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills or Testaments by me heretofore made.
