Robert Church of Henderson County Kentucky being weak
in body but of sound mind and knowing the uncertainty of
human life do hereby make Constable & Ordain this my last
Will & Testament in the following form and manner (To wit)

1st My Will is that all my just Estate of every description that I do
possess I have given to my son Rhenbow Church five hundred and
fifty dollars to be paid hereafter also to my son Samuel
Church three hundred & twenty two dollars my Will is
that my Executor pay to Samuel Church one hundred
dollars more out of my personal Estate not otherwise devised
I further Will to my two sons Rhenbow Church & Samuel
Church two negro Slaves Jeph & Isaac to be equally divided
between them

3rd Having given my Daughter Elizabeth Hope one negro Slave
herebefore named Matilda as her real property my Will is
that my Daughter Elizabeth Hope shall have one hundred & fifteen
dollars more paid her by my Executor to be raised out of my personal
estate, not otherwise devised

4th My Will is that my land I now reside on shall be
remained undivided between my children hereafter named
(to wit) Richard Church, Susanna Floyd, Mary Church
Robert Church, Elam Church, Masona Church, Edwin
Church, James Church, & Ann Church for the Space of
five years from the date of this Will in order that all my
children last mentioned should continue together & have a
home that they may resort to for the Space of five years
at which time my Will is that my land above mentioned
should be equally with the following Slaves which
is to remain on the land of or said for the Space of
five years also (to wit) Nelson, George, Jimmy

My John Smoky, between Richard Church, Susanna
Floyd, Mary Church, Rhenbow Church, Elam Church, Masona
Church, Edwin Church, James Church, & Ann Church
equally with all them hereafter which said Slaves
last mentioned are to be employed for the maintenance
of my children last named above

5th Whereas I have given my Daughter Susanna Floyd
three hundred dollars herebefore my Will is that the
said three hundred dollars should be charged to her
at the division as a part of her legacy named in my Will

6th My Will is that Mary Church, Robert Church, Elam
Church, Masona Church, Edwin Church, James Church
& Ann Church shall have each one third of the interest
in Cow and Calf in addition to what I have given them
herebefore as their own property whenever they may
think proper to take them out of my personal Estate
Also my Will is that Masona Church, Elam Church
Edwin Church, James Church, & Ann Church shall
have each of them a good saddle given them to be
paid for out of my Estate whenever they may think proper
to call for them in addition to what I have herebefore given
them

7th My Will is that Edwin Church, James Church
& Ann Church should be sent to School until they receive
a good English Education which is to be paid for out
of my personal Estate property

8th My Will is that if any of my children should die
before they marry or arrive to the age of twenty one years
that their Estate should devolve to the surviving legatee
Except Rhenbow Church, Samuel Church & Elizabeth

9th My Will is that all my personal Estate of every
description not herebefore devised shall be sold &
equally divided between Richard Church, Susanna
Floyd, Mary Church, Robert Church, Elam Church
Masona Church, Edwin Church, James Church
& Ann Church

10th My Will is that Robert Church, Elam Church
Edwin Church & James Church should

each of them have a good Book given them as they arrived at the age of twenty One Year to be paid for out of my Personal Estate

I do hereby appoint Richard Church & Robert Church Executors to this my Last Will & Testament

Knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, being in perfect mind and memory, I make this my last Will and Testament in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety six, first I bequeath my soul to God from whence it came, my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner and as touching my worldly affairs of to all my Just Debts being paid, I Will and bequeath my Negro boy George to my Son Benjamin Howard my land and all my free small estate to be equally divided between my three Daughters to wit Elizabeth Hicks, Charity Elliott, Susan Garrison & say I Will and bequeath my negro woman Leana to be sold to a highest bidder and one half of the money arising for her I Will and bequeath to my Son Joseph Howard and the other half to be equally divided amongst my lawful and our named heirs. I wish the before mentioned property to be valued on a Credit of nine months, signed and acknowledged in the presence of us this 30th day of February the year above written
