thence running S. 29° W. to the back side of the Orchard fence, thence
1 pole up the Orchard fence on the back side towards Robert McGormick's
land to a stake on the back side of the Orchard fence, thence S 29° W.
300 poles to the back line of said tract, thence up the back line of said
tract to where it joins Robert McGormick's land, thence with his land
to the Ohio River & the beginning, containing forty acres one eighth more
or less - For her third of the negroes belonging to the late
Hugh McGormick we assign the widow a Negro boy by

the name of Sam & fifty dollars for her thirds of all the money
belonging to the Estate offered according to the amount as appears
upon the books belonging to said Estate arising from the sale of personal
property as appears from the Sale Bill, four hundred & fifty four dollars
& 75 Cents, all which is assigned & respectfully reported to your
honorable body - Given under our hands this 20th of Oct. 1837.
