

We the undersigned Commissioners agreeable to an Order of the Henderson County Court, after having been sworn, as the law requires have agreed and fixed on the following boundary for the dowry of Harriet McCallister in the land of her deceased husband Samuel K. McCallister. Beginning at a small Oak tree on the Bank of the Ohio River near the old Camp Shiloh thence running down with said River sixty five poles to Richard Warfields Corner, thence with said Warfields line South 50° East 300 poles to a large Burr oak, thence North 40° East 30 poles to a stake, thence with a straight line to the Beginning - We also assign to her a negro Boy called Modern and fifty Dollars in money for her dowry in the Slaves Given under our hands the 25th day of May 1837.

The undersigned commissioners, appointed to administer the estate of George Green senior deceased among his heirs by order of the County Court of Henderson at their April County Court in the year 1837. Respectfully reports, that we returned the slaves to the sum of Six thousand one hundred & twenty five Dollars, and that the personal Estate sold for the sum of \$260 and after deducting \$13 being 5 percent on that amount allotted by us to William Green as his commission for making the sale & taking the notes, leaves the sum of \$247 which added to the sum of three hundred advanced by the decedent to Richard Green and the sum of \$1256. Four hundred & eighty six dollars advanced to John Green another of the heirs, makes the whole amount of the Estate to be divided among the seven heirs to be the sum of \$7208 Seven thousand Two Hundred & Eight dollars, and the share of each heir one thousand & twenty nine & 7/8 Dollars - \$1029 & 7/8 having valued the negroes & elapsed them into seven lots, and the names and a valuation of the negroes written on 7 pieces of paper were placed in a hat & drawn out by the heirs as follows
