 I Archib Gallowsy of the County of Henderson and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and feeble bodily health, do this day in the presence of Almighty God and three Witnesses make this my last will and Testament to wit after my death when my just debts are all paid and Funeral expenses I bequeath my Wife Mary Ellen Gallowsy to have and to hold all of my property both real and personal consisting of One hundred and eight acres more or less of land in said County and State lying on the West of Green River also notes and accounts amounting to about two hundred Dollars One Horse One Cow and calf and eleven dogs and all my Household and Kitchen Furniture after the death of my Wife I will bequeath Ann Wilson my Sister and her children One half of my land and the Remainder to Margaret Jane Johnson my Wife's daughter
