 illness made and published the following nuncupative Will, as his last
 will and Testament - I give and bequeath to my brother Hiram Flinn
 all the interest I have in the Estate of my deceased Father. I also give him
 all the ready money which I now have say \$25 - and the following notes
 of hand due me, Lewis, a note in the hands of Daniel Justice for
 \$35 in Indiana Rockville Parke County on Thomas Nebril. One note on
 John Carby for \$58. of Pennsylvania, Warren County, and in the hands
 of James Ramsey for Collection - Sept 8th 1835

I Daniel Frame of Warrick County in the State of Indiana do
 make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and
 making void, all former wills by me at any time heretofore made -
 First I direct that my body be decently interred, and that my funeral be
 conducted in a manner corresponding with my Estate and situation in life,
 and as to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to entrust me with

I dispose of the same in the following manner to wit, I direct first that all
 my just debts and funeral expenses be paid, as soon after my decease as
 possible, out of the first money that shall come to the hands of my executor from
 any portion of my Estate real or personal. I also direct that my plantation
 that I now live on shall be and remain the absolute property of my beloved wife
 so long as she shall live, also all my house hold furniture, also four Cows, an
 a Calf, what Stock Hogs and Sheep that she may select, also the young or colts
 of deer, and Wagon, also the mares called Jill, and Doll and Dolls Colt
 also a Colt called Sampson, and three Horses, also a sufficiency of all kind
 of provisions, to last her and family one year, I also direct that there shall be
 a credit given on a note of hand that I hold against Thomas Williams for
 Two hundred Dollars for fifty Dollars. I also direct that all my personal
 Estate be sold, except such as I have above mentioned, I also direct that
 my tract of land on the island be sold as soon as possible. I hereby make
 and ordain my worthy and esteemed friend Edward Baker executor of this
 my last Will and Testament - Witness whereof I Daniel Frame the
 Testator have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of
 August One thousand Eight hundred and thirty five.
