Knowing the uncertainty of human life I, **Elizabeth James** formerly **Elizabeth Langley** of the County of Henderson State of Kentucky, do hereby make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the following words and figures: I give and bequeath to my sister **Caroline M. Dillingham** formerly **Caroline M. Langley** and my husband **John R. Dillingham** during their natural lives or either of them my interest being one half of the tract of land on which we now live and which tract belongs to said **Dillingham** and myself in common, and at their death the said interest in said land shall be divided equally between the children of my sister **Judith M. Bauman** formerly **Judith M. Langley** and my brother **Samuel M. Langley** or his children provided that should my sister **Caroline** survive her husband, then she shall have said interest in said land in fee simple to dispose of in any manner she may desire, 2nd I give and bequeath to my sisters **Sally C.
