I Harrison A. Powell of Henderson County, Kentucky, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament as follows viz: 1st I appoint my sons C. H. Powell and W. H. Powell, as executors of this my last will and testament - 2nd I devise that my executors shall sell my one and lot at Roberts Station, in this County, and all the personally not herein bequeathed, the proceeds thereof to be apart of my estate, 3rd I devise that all my just debts shall be paid by my executors as soon as possible after my decease, 4th I will and bequeath to my son Richard Powell, one hundred dollars, 5th I will and bequeath to my daughter, Lucy C. Powell three hundred & fifty dollars, also one bedstead and bedding to be selected and set apart for her by her mother, 6th I will and bequeath to my son Harrison A. Powell, One hundred & fifty dollars, also one bedstead and bedding to be selected by and left with his mother in trust for him independent of any bond or cash is return, and to be given to him whenever he in other sees proper, 7th I will and bequeath to my daughter Virginia A. Powell the same as to my son Harrison A. Powell, subject to the same conditions - 8th I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Judith Ann Powell, my entire farm (about 300 acres) and my household lot near Corydon Ky. during her natural life, and at her death to her children - 9th I will and bequeath to her for her sole use and benefit forever, one cow, eight hogs, all to be selected by her, and all the household and kitchen furniture, subject to the foregoing provisions, and all the provisions and feed on hand, 9th I devise that my son C. H. Powell, shall qualify at my death, as guardian for my two children, Harrison A. Powell and Virginia A. Powell; done at my home near Corydon, Henderson County, Kentucky, February ninth (9) one thousand eight hundred and seventy five (1875)
