 provided. 2nd I give and bequeath to my Son Monroe the sum of ten
 dollars. 3rd I give and bequeath to my Son Albin the sum of ten dollars.
 4th I give and bequeath to my Son Claudius the sum of one hundred
 dollars. 5th I give and bequeath to my Son John Bush the sum of ten
 hundred dollars. 6th I give and bequeath to my daughter Cena M. White
 the sum of three hundred dollars. 7th To my Son Jenks W. I give and
 bequeath the sum of ten dollars. 8th To my Grand Children the children of
 my son Jenks W. I give and bequeath my negro girl Clara.
 9th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Amelia & my two negro girls
 Mary and Ella. 10th It is my will and desire that my Executors herein-
 after named shall divide my household furniture as near as possible between
 my daughters Cena M. White and Amelia. 11th It is further my will and
 desire that my executors hereinafter named shall sell my negro woman Delia
 and her youngest child Sam Delia. And out of the proceeds of said sale
 pay all my just and lawful debts funeral expenses and the legacies
 herein before made to my grand children Sallie Johnson, John Johnson, Elliott Johnson, Minnie Johnson, Rachabell Johnson
 Saml. C. Johnson and the legacies to my children Monroe, Albin &
 Claudius & John Bush Jenks W. & Cena M. White And should
 any money remain from the proceeds of said sale after paying my said
 debts and legacies it is my will and desire that my executors shall pay the
 same over to my Daughter Amelia. I hereby appoint and ordain
 my sons Jenks W. Williams and John Bush Williams executors of this
 my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other former wills

Henderson County Ky 21 March 1868. I Samuel Bugg of the County and
 State aforesaid being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and ordain
 this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others. 1st I give and bequeath
 my just debts and funeral expenses paid. 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter
 Harriett the negro John Smith one Negro Boy named Isaac during her life and
 at her death to belong to her Children. 3rd I give and bequeath to my son
 Pleasant F. Bugg a negro Boy named Bob to have and to hold during his life and
 at his death to belong to his Children. 4th I give and bequeath to my son
 Samuel Bugg a negro girl named Martha to have and to hold as long as
 he lives and at his death to belong to his Children. 5th I give and
 bequeath to the two children of my deceased daughter Delila Gallaway fifty dollars
 each provided they are living and come forward and claim it and if they are
 dead then the above mentioned sum to the rest of my heirs. 6th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Almira fifty dollars and no more. 7th I give and bequeath to my son Saml. Bugg seventy five acres of land including
 the house and farm on which I now live and the remainder of the tract which I possess
 as seventy five acres. I give and bequeath to my son Pleasant F. Bugg and my
 Daughter Almira to be equally divided between them. 8th I give and bequeath in case there should not be a sufficiency of surplus funds on hand
 at my death to pay my just debts and funeral expenses and the different sums
 bequeathed in money to my Daughter Almira and my grand children I wish
 the negroes hereunto to raise the necessary amount. 9th I hereby appoint my
 friend Sam Johnson my Executor with full power to carry out the provisions
 of this last will and Testament.

All bonds notes including all right in possession or expectancy to the following named person to be among them equally divided and if any one named should die before my death I leave then their respective children to represent their ancestor as follow towards Mrs Anna Holloway Mrs Indiana McFarland of Henderson County Ky Camilla Smith Lucy Smith and William I Smith Children of my brother (who is deceased) Peter I Smith - residents of Daviess County Kentucky with one exception Mrs Anna Holloway who is now a resident of Henderson County Ky. Obadiah Smith now resident of the State of Indiana (Lucy Smith of Louisville Kentucky Mrs Harriet Morris (who I am told has intermarried with some person I am ignorant of the last named) Children of my brother of John I Smith Mrs Virginia Gambel Mrs Mary M Pitts being daughters of my sister Mary B Matthe. To Harry and To Hold the same property both personal & real to keep and then here forever. And in order to be better understood and further certainty of the meaning of this my Will and Testament I do hereby enumerate the said decess and Legatee Mrs Anna Holloway Mrs Indiana McFarland Camilla Smith Lucy Smith and William I Smith Children of my brother Peter I Smith decd. Obadiah Smith of the State of Indiana Lucy Smith of Louisville Ky Mrs Harriet Morris Children of my brother John I Smith Mrs Virginia Gambel and Mrs Mary B Pitts daughters of my sister Mary B Matthe. Among all of whom my said estate is to be divided. And I desire by make Constitution and appoint my nephew William I Smith of Daviess County Kentucky my executor to carry out in full all the provision of this my Will. And further I hereby revoke all and every other will by me excepting this one of this my date.
