

6 Langley Will

In addition to the Devise and bequests herein before mentioned to my wife Juliana I devise and bequeath to my said wife Juliana all my right title and claim to any Estate, lands, lots or other property which my said wife is entitled to, or claims in the State of Indiana. I constitute and appoint my wife Juliana executrix and Fayette Posey and John G. Holloway Executors of this my last Will and Testament, which said Executors and Executors in Case my perishable property should not be sufficient for the payment of my debts, all of which I desire to be paid, are hereby vested with full power and authority to sell such other portion or part of my Estate as in their opinion shall be most advantageous, as will be fully sufficient for the payment of all my just debts. I have to revoke all Wills and Testaments heretofore by me made.
