

Will of A. F. Kennedy

In the name of God Amen:-

I A. F. Kennedy being of sound mind & disposing memory do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking any & all wills previously made by me

First I desire that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid.

Second After the payment of my just debts & funeral expenses I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Bridget W. Kennedy absolutely all of my property - real, personal or mixed (except the watch hereinafter mentioned) to sell use or dispose of as she may deem best so long as she shall live. At her death if any of said property remains undisposed of I will & bequeath one half thereof to my brother Milton Kennedy & the remaining one half to my wife heirs or such person or persons as she may desire to have same as expressed by her will.

Third I will & bequeath unto my brother Milton Kennedy my watch.

Fourth I nominate & appoint my beloved wife Bridget W. Kennedy Executrix of this my last will & testament without bond

In testimony whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand this 30th day of July 1896
