I, Elizabeth F. Woodruff of the City of Henderson State of Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and ordain this instrument of writing to be my last Will and Testament. (1st) I will that all my just debts to be paid (2nd) I give and bequeath to Mrs Mary E. Sanger of Lexington Ky my silver watch (3rd) I give to my dear daughter Maria Ruddy my watch and chain (4th) The residue of my estate both real and personal property and mixed including whatever has been or may be devised to me by my Father, Mother or Husband, I give and bequeath to my daughter Rosa E. Gayle as full sample to use and dispose of as she deems best and in case she should marry again to be her separate estate free from the control disposition or disposition of any husband she may have. (6th) I direct that there be no inventory or appraisement made of my effects, and in case my daughter Rosa E. Gayle shall carry out or cause to be carried out the first four clauses of this will then I direct that there be no legal administration or settlement of my estate but should an administrator be necessary then I authorize my daughter Rosa E. Gayle to designate some competent person who shall be appointed by the Court and allowed to qualify without bond.
