Will of
Jackson McBlain

I Jackson McBlain of the City of Henderson State of Kentucky do make and publish this writing as and for my last will & testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

First - I will and desire that all my debts shall be first paid and it will have to be done in part at least from the sale of some of my lands and I hereby authorize and direct my Executors hereinafter named, to sell and convey to the purchaser or purchasers so much of my land as may be necessary for that purpose and I leave it to them to use their judgment for the best interest of my estate as to the part or parcels they will sell and in making said sale or sales if they think best they may divide any tract or tracts and sell a part or all of any tract or tracts but only so much land shall be sold as is necessary to pay said debts my funeral expenses and other payment hereinafter directed to be made after disposing of my personal property all of which I direct to be sold except such as I shall hereinafter dispose of and specifically mention.

2nd - I will and bequeath to my wife Helen the house and lot where I now reside situated on Main Street in the City of Henderson together with all my house hold & kitchen furniture for and during her natural life or so long as she remains a widow but at her death or marriage said house & lot and furniture shall revert to my estate and be disposed of for the benefit of my five boys Jackson Hunt Willie Henry and George McBlain and I would like for these all to live together if they will.

3 - I will and bequeath to my wife Helen Two Thousand dollars to be paid to her by my Executors as soon as practical after my debts & funeral expenses are paid and may be paid out of any money coming to their hands either from the sale of real or personal property but I wish my Executors to advance her such a part thereof as she may require for her support during the settling of my

estate. I also give her my horse and buggy
or my carriage which ever she may wish to
take and the provision herein made for my wife
is to be in lieu of dower in my estate.

4th — I will and bequeath to my daughter
Mrs. Annie W. Mayor the house & lot of ground
on which she now resides situated on the corner
at the intersection of Elm & Powell street in
Henderson Ky adjoining Johnsons property for
and during her natural life and at her death
to be equally divided between her three boys.

Jackson, Saml & Alex Mayor.

5th — I will and bequeath my jewelry to my
five boys to be divided between them as they may
agree except I want George to have my watch
and they can make the division by having it
valued and those taking the more valuable
paying the difference to those getting the less valuable.

6th — I will and bequeath all the rest and residue
of my estate, wherever situated to my five boys
Jackson, Hunt, Willie, Henry, and George McLain
to be equally divided between them so soon as my
debts are paid and my estate settled up & shares
shared alike.

7th — I leave it to my Executors to use their judgment
as to the carrying on of any of my farms any longer
than the year in which my decease may happen but
I wish all my contracts carried out — the balance is paid
for next year.

8th I nominate and appoint Robt S. Sigmund, George M.
Atkinson, Jackson McLain Jr and my wife Helen
to be Executors, Executrix of this my last will and
request the county court to allow them to qualify
and act as such without giving security and I
request said Sigmund to consult with the others
and to attend to the business part of settling up
my estate.
