In the name of God Amen; I Kasiiah Sugg of the County of Henderson and State of Kentucky, being advanced in years out of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say First, I give and bequeath to my two daughters Emily Sugg and Julia Sugg the house and lot of ground in the City of Henderson Kentucky on which I now reside which lot is bounded as follows Beginning at a stake on the east side of the first street back of Green street 177 feet from its intersection with the Madisonville road, thence S 59° E 177 feet to a stake thence N 31° E 60 feet to a stake thence N 59° W 177 feet to a stake on the above named street thence with said street S 31° W 60 feet to the Beginning which said lot I give to them absolutely and their heirs or assigns forever. Second, I desire that so much of my lands in Mississippi County State of Arkansas, as may be necessary to raise the sum of Three Hundred Dollars and costs & expenses of the sale & conveyance be sold by my Executors hereafter named or by the one of them who may duly qualify as such, either at public or private sale as he or they may think best and he or they making the sale are hereby authorized directed and empowered to make and execute deliver proper deeds to the purchasers of the land thus sold with Covenants of General Warranty. I devise and give the sum of Three hundred dollars to my daughter Susan Ann Hancock widow of John L. Hancock absolutely - this amount is to be raised as herein before provided for and is to be paid to her by my Executors as soon as said sale of land can be made and the money therefrom realized. Third, All the remainder of my lands in the State of Arkansas after the sale aforesaid, I give bequeath and devise to the following of my children to-wit Caroline Stephens widow of John Stephens Maria Parr wife of James Parr Edgar Sugg Willie Sugg Gabriel D. Sugg William Sugg Mary Dixon wife of John Dixon & Lorena Goodell wife of William Goodell to be divided equally between them, to hold the said lands to them and their heirs or assigns forever. Fourth, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my sons Edgar Sugg and Willie Sugg Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this ninth day of November in the year One Thousand Eight hundred and Sixty Seven.
