

Will of Mrs Jane H. Taylor

Cauders, Kentucky, Sept 29th 1896

Thomas H. Taylor of the City of Henderson, State of Kentucky realizing the uncertainty of life do make & declare this to be my last will & testament.

First, I will & direct that my debts & funeral expenses be paid out of my estate.

Second, After the payment of my said debts & funeral expenses, I will & bequeath what ever property I may own, or in which I may have an interest at the time of my death, whether real personal or mixed to my son Thomas H. Taylor of Union County, State of Kentucky. My said son Thos H Taylor has been of great comfort & assistance to me & has for years attended to & managed my business without cost or expense to me & contributed greatly to my wants and comforts, and I feel like compensating him, so I will & devise to him all the property of whatever kind or character I may own at the time of my death. I further appoint my said son Thos H Taylor the executor of my will & direct that he qualify without executing bond.

I Elizabeth Lawrence in being of good health in mind, do make this my last will and Testament this June 11th 1891. I do will and request that after my death all of my property which consist of forty acres of land near Couplon Ky, be sold and after pay my my debts, or burial expenses, the proceeds of the sale of said land with any other money I may have or note or claims of any kind be first disposed as follows-

First, I give Bettie Lawrence my Grand Daughter one Hundred Dollars, and the balance to be equally divided between my children W^m Lawrence's (children) & Emma Lawrence, children and Mary Triplett my daughter - and Samuel Watson my grand daughter that is to say divided in four parts - Samuel Watson one fourth of sd estate after deducting one hundred dollars for Bettie Lawrence, and Mary Triplett one fourth, the children of Emma Lawrence one fourth and the children of W^m Lawrence one fourth and I hereby request and appoint my grand daughter Bettie Lawrence and my grand son Elsie Lawrence Executors and Exrs - to carry out my last will & Testament, and I hereby sign and direct the foregoing witnessed as my last will - Done at Couplon Ky, day & date as above written -
