First: I desire that any just debts I may owe at the date of my decease together with the necessary expenses of my funeral be paid.
Second: I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Katie H. Stanley & his wife may reside at such home with her, and that my husband, Geo H. Smith may also reside at such home if he so desires and likewise my brother H. Stanley if he may desire to do so. I desire also that if my daughter wishes a buggy for her own use, that enough of the proceeds of the personal property be devoted to the purchase of said vehicle for her.

I constitute & appoint my friend Bonas Hill, Executor of this will & request that the Court granting probate hereof in the event he fails or refuses to act, will appoint any good responsible person as Administrator with the will annexed.
