Will

Know all Men - That I Martha E Williamson of Henderson Ky do make this to be my last will & Testament as follows. First. I will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executor and for this purpose I will to my son James E Williamson fifty feet front running back same with the full depth of my lot and beginning at Reifers corner and running thence back as aforesaid fronting on Main Street including my old residence this I give to him that he may sell or mortgage for money sufficient to pay my debts and funeral expenses and to this end I desire that the proceeds of the sale of the same or any money borrowed thereon be first applied. Second. I will and bequeath to my son James E Williamson the remainder of my lot and which fronts fifty feet on Main Street and lays on the corner of the intersection of 10th and Main Street and runs back same width with 10th Street 150 feet and has a new Cottage house on it, which house and lot I give to him in fee simple. Third. I give and bequeath to my son James E Williamson all the rest and residue of my estate including what may remain from the lot first named, if any after the payment of my debts and funeral expenses. Fourth. I nominate constitute and appoint my son James E Williamson my Executor of this my last will and agree that the Court allow him to qualify without giving security. I hereby revoke any and all former wills heretofore made by me. In witness of the foregoing I have signed my name this June 5 1888.
