

I, Susan P. Scaper, widow of William Scaper, dec'd, of Henderson County
 Kentucky, do make and publish this writing as and for my true and only
 last will and testament. My personal expenses and just debts should I
 leave any are to be paid full out of my estate. To each of my
 two daughters Maria S. Gayley and Susan K. Young I give the sum of
 One Hundred Dollars (\$100) with which to purchase a piano.
 To my grand daughter Susan Burnett I give one hundred and fifty
 dollars (\$150) and to each of the other children of my daughter Susan
 Dillan, viz: Clarence, Charles, Suzzee and Orlie, I give the sum of one
 hundred dollars (\$100). To my grand daughter Susan Scaper, I give
 One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150) and to better the other child of my
 son Thomas Scaper, I give One Hundred Dollars (\$100). To my grand
 daughter Susan K. Small I give One Hundred and Fifty Dollars
 (\$150) and to each of the other children of my daughter Maria Small,
 viz: Doug, Katie, Marriana, William and Stephen I give the sum of
 One Hundred dollars (\$100). To my grand child Fannie Caruthers
 I give one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) and to Suzzee the other
 child of my daughter Kate S. Caruthers I give the sum of One Hun-
 dred Dollars (\$100). To my grand son William child of my daughter
 Maria S. Gayley I give the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100).
 To my grand daughter Sue child of my son William Scaper, I give
 One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150) and to each of the other
 children of my son William, viz: Harry and Lucie I give One Hundred
 Dollars (\$100). To my grand child Francis child of my son Robert
 Scaper I give one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) and to each of the
 three children of my son Robert, viz: Jane, William and Annie I give
 the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100). My son Harry Scaper is to
 have two good horses and a buggy and harness, a room fitted up with
 good bed, cabinet and furniture to suit said articles to be selected by
 him from property on hand at the time of my death or purchasable
 with money of my estate as he may elect. To the colored boy
 Frank whom I reared and who calls himself "Frank Scaper," being
 the son of my old nurse Sue, I give the sum of One Hundred Dollars
 (\$100). Should any grand child of mine be born after the making
 and execution of this will and before my death I give to such after-
 born grand child the sum of One Hundred Dollars. The several
 legacies herein named are to be paid to the legacies respectively, or to
 their guardians, or soon after my death as can reasonably be done
 without detriment to my estate. Should I survive any of the legacies
 of any of the cheerful legacies herein before named, such legacy is
 thereupon to lapse and become void. After paying the funeral expenses
 and debts as herein provided all the rest and residue of my estate,
 of every description, real and personal including houses, land, furniture
 and effects, books, silverware &c. is to be equally divided among my
 children, sons and daughters, share and share alike, and should

I survive any child of mine now living the share of such child is to
 go to him or her here. I appoint my son Harry Scaper to be the
 Executor of this my last will and testament and he may qualify
 as such Executor without bond. Witness my hand this 3 day of
 February 1886.

 bequest to her of \$150 is as to the said Orlie, in lieu of the general
 legacy of \$100 to after-born grand children. Witness my hand
