stock in the Henderson Mining Manufacturing Company and

the Henderson Building and Loan Association and if I should
die before said series matures she is to complete the payment
requiring thereon after my death.

Third. I give to my sister *Mrs C D Neworthy* my books
and furniture.

Fourth. I give to my nephew *Joseph Clore* son of *Rafe*
Clore my Gold Watch.

Fifth. All the rest and residue of my estate I give
equally to my brothers and sisters living and to the
Children of those that may be dead the Children of those
dying to take the interest of their deceased parent or step-
parent.

Sixth. I direct that an inventory be taken of my interest
in the new firm of *Joseph Clores Sons* and that my brothers
Rafe and *J C Clore* be given the option to purchase my
interest in the saw and planing Mills the Machinery
furniture &c. I mean the entire plant at the price of four
thousand dollars payable in 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 years without interest
and without security other than a lien reserved on said
property and my interest in the lumber and other material
at wholesale invoice prices.

Seventh. I nominate and appoint my brother *Rafe*
Clore and brother in law *C D Neworthy* Executors of this
will and request that no security be required of them
