I Laura M Holloway of the County of Henderson and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing memory, and wishing to avail myself of the right given under the will of my deceased husband John D Holloway dec^d, do make this my last will and testament. 1st I devise to my son Wm S Holloway and W S Holloway in trust, the sum of five thousand dollars. They are to invest said sum in a good and secure manner, in stocks bonds or lands, and are authorized in their discretion to pay the annual income therefrom, a any part thereof to my son W S Holloway during his natural life. They are to be under no legal obligation to do so, nor is said W S Holloway to have the right to compel them to do so, but they are to have the right to exercise their own discretion and will about the matter. At the death of the said W S Holloway the said sum is to be equally divided among my children, or their descendants if dead 'per stirpes'. 2nd I devise to my son W S Holloway all the stock, teams, tools and farming implements now owned at my death, subject to the provision made in the 3rd clause of this will. 3rd I devise to each of my daughters and daughters-in-law a dowry and self. If not or less than my executors are to purchase same for them. 4th I devise to my grand daughter Sophie Cammell five hundred dollars. 5th I hereby expressly revoke any and all wills heretofore made by me. 6th I nominate and appoint my son W S Holloway Executor of this my last will and testament.
