Item I Give and Devise all the Lands and Slaves herein bequeathed to my beloved
Wife to my sons Isaac Abraham & Joseph Hite to be equally divided among
them after her Decease to them their Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item I Give and Devise unto John Hite son of my Brother Joseph Hite Two
hundred Acres of Land to him his heirs & Assigns for ever.

Item I Give Devise unto William Hite son of my brother Joseph Hite Four hundred
Acres of Land to him his heirs and Assigns for ever. and order thereby
my Executors to lay off the said Lands above devised unto my Nephews
John and William Hite in any part of the tracts that I shall have
in the District of Kentucky as they shall think most advantageous
agreeable to my said two Nephews without Injuring the Value of their
adjacent lands from which they are taken provided that the land
devised to my said Nephews be good in Quality and fit for a permanent
Settlement.

Item I Give and devise unto Hannah Banometre six hundred Acres of Land
during her Natural life lying on the waters of Jessamine Creek
Adam Stephens on the North and the land of John Bowman on the
