except such as will be hereafter disposed of which
is to fulfill any contract I may have made for the
conveyance of lots of Land. The land for my share
the West War (to wit) 3000 acres on the North west
the Ohio between the main ^{and}trato Locater by my son
Robert Breckenridge one third part of which he
is entitled to for his trouble in Locating, the other two
may be Equally divided between my three sons
(to wit) James, Robert and Henry Brown Breckenridge
and one thousand acres part of the same Warrent
I had ^{located} on the Ohio opposite to the mouth of the
Tuloh, may be be equally divided among my three
sons above named to them and their heirs forever.

I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife
Lenny Breckenridge and my Brother Robert Exor of
