but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the
certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous
to settle my worldly affairs and thereby to be better prepared to leave the world
when it shall please God call me hence do therefore make and ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following Viz. First and
principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my
body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor here
after named, and after my funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as
follows to wit: I desire that my son James Travis shall have two dollars
to be paid to him by my Executor hereafter to be mentioned out of the remain
der if any may be after my funeral charges as above named shall be
paid, as his former conduct in life to me hath rendered himself unworthy
to be taken any further notice of And that the above mentioned sum of
two dollars after the manner as above written shall go in full satisfaction
of all right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever which he may
now or in any way pretend to have or claim of, in or to all or any part of my
estate whatever = It is my will that after all charges as above
written arising from burial be paid that the residue or remainder
of my Estate which consists of clothing, household and Kitchen furniture
shall be equally divided between my brother Conrad Rush and my son
Jacob Schimmerhorn, both of the County and State aforesaid to the proper
use and benefit of them and their heirs forever And lastly I do hereby
constitute and appoint my brother Conrad Rush above named to be sole

of my Estate which consists of clothing, household and Kitchen furniture
shall be equally divided between my brother Conrad Rush and my son
Jacob Shimmerhorn, both of the County and State aforesaid to the proper
use and benefit of them and their heirs forever. And lastly I do hereby
constitute and appoint my brother Conrad Rush above named to be sole
Executor of this my last will and testament, ratifying and confirming
this and none other to be my last will and testament, In testimony whereof
I have set my hand and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of May
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and nineteen
