

Be it remembered that I Anthony Miller of Jefferson County
and State of Kentucky, being weak of body, but of sound and per-
fect mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and
Testament in manner and form following. That is to say, To wit:

I wish my brother Buckner Miller to have my negro woman Betty
and Hannah, as also my negro boy Isaac at whatever price they
may be valued at, at twelve months credit. And provided he does
not take them at such valuation and credit, I wish my brother
Robert Miller to have them on the same terms and if he does not take
them, I wish them to be sold altogether, as it is not my wish that they
should be separated.

Secondly I wish my two negro boys Jack and Ned to be sold, as
well as all the ballance of my real and personal estate, except
my chest and home which I will unto my brother Buckner Miller.
Thirdly All the monies arising from the foregoing sales, I
wish to be disposed of in the following manner To wit:

To be equally divided between Thomas Miller son of my brother
John Miller dec'd, William Miller son of my brother John
Miller dec'd, Lucinda Miller, daughter of my brother Richard
Miller, Donatha Jane Miller, daughter of my brother Buckner Miller
James Buckner Bright, son of my sister Nancy Bright, Anthony
Miller son of my brother Robert Miller, William Thomas Winlock,
son of my sister Mary Winlock and Donatha Ann Pomeroy daugh-
ter of my sister Jane Pomeroy, when they shall have arrived at
the age of twenty one years, or whenever any one of them gets
to that age, she should then receive his or her pro-

the age of twenty one years, or whenever any one of them gets married, it is my wish that he or she should then receive his or her proportion with the interest that may have accrued or whenever any one of them arrives at the year of twenty one, it is my wish that he or she should then draw his or her part of the aforesaid money with the interest that may have accrued. And it is also my wish that if any one of my aforesaid nephews or nieces should die before they are twenty one years of age or before they get married, that the proportion that would have fallen to them shall be equally divided with those that may remain at the time and in the manner aforesaid.

I do appoint my brother Buckner and Robert Miller Executors of this my last will and testament and do hereby revoke all others heretofore made.
