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I Charles Holloway of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky being of sound memory and mind; but feeling that weak in health of body do constitute and bequeath this my last will and testament.

1st I lend to my beloved wife Mary Holloway all my property both real and personal during her natural life and at her death to be disposed of as shall be hereafter named.

2^d It is my desire that each of my unmarried children, viz Mary W Holloway, Hugh W Holloway, Susan Holloway and Mary Ann Holloway shall have a servant share out of my estate previous to a division equal in value to those given my children already married.

3rd After discharging the legacies above named an equal division of property to be made between Mary W Holloway, Abby W Gray, Emily M and Abner Anderson infant heirs of my deceased daughter Emily to have one share, Daniel S Miller, Charles Holloway and Hugh W Holloway, Susan Holloway and Mary Ann Holloway.

I further desire that an equal share with the above named children shall be lent to my daughter Eliza Brown formerly Eliza Short during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided with each of her children.

The debts due and from the late Thomas Short her former husband is to be taken out of her part and an equal dividend made among my aforesaid children, looking forward to futurity with pleasure I resign myself to the hands of our divine Creator.
