will and testament forth I have moved my  
soul to the almighty god and my body to the  
grave with a decent funeral I do the leave and  
bequeath to my loving wife ten thirds of all my  
Estate during her natural life except <sup>ing</sup> and  
Margret she are to be free when my son of  
Joe Hanyman is at the age of twenty one  
he is to be free and Margret when he is at  
the age of twenty one <sup>he is to have</sup> Twenty  
Pounds when Free and Margret Ten pounds  
when free part in Stock and part in money  
and if any of my heirs detains them after they  
are free they are to pay so Twenty five pounds  
per year and to Margret Ten pounds per year  
I give and bequeath one bond on Robert Davis  
of Sixty Eight pounds and another on Elias  
Torby Eighty five pounds and two hundred  
and of Land Shelby County of a premtion in  
the name of Fuby Lane for which I paid  
George Rush forty pounds Conditionally  
if he will not purchase Land and if he will

by said Trust to be sold at its Value and if  
not purchased the money to be returned to my  
Estate as follows (to wit) and all the proceeds  
to be divided as follows I give to my son Josiah  
or his heirs the Sum of Twenty pounds and the  
Two negroes Agar and Pallas known before his  
death to be free and then Increase at the age of  
Twenty Eight years of age I give and bequeath to  
my Daughter Mary and her heirs Ten pounds  
and to my son David Ten pounds and the remain-  
-er to be equally divided between my four Children  
Elijah, Charles, Elizabeth & Rebecca to them and  
their heirs forever I have and bequeath to my  
Son John all my three tracts of Land where I now  
live on and in Jefferson County with all  
the moveable property Except what I have  
giving to my beloved wife with Two obligations  
on Jonathan Boone of thirteen pounds each  
In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal this 15 day of June 1798.

take the Oath or affirmation of Robert  
Ward another Witness to said will
