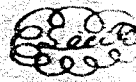


I also give to my son Abraham Reynolds thirty dollars in like manner

divided amongst them when they become of age.

I give and bequeath to John Root and Mary his wife each of them one
dollar in full of their shares, I before having given them what I allowed
them. I give also to Jacob Goodman and his wife Sarah one dollar each
I give also to Basil Williams who intermarried with my daughter Elizabeth
two dollars, I having otherwise provided for his wife.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my said dear wife Margaret
Sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking and doing
away all other will or wills by me in any wise made and lastly my
will and meaning is and I do hereby order and appoint that if any
differences, dispute or question or controversy shall be moved, arise or
happen, concerning any gift, bequest, matter or thing in this my
will given and bequeathed, express'd or contained, that there no suit or
suits in law or equity or otherwise, shall be brought, commenced or pro-
cutted for and concerning the same, but the same shall be referred wholly
to the award, order and determination of my friends William Edwards
Abraham Keller and Jacob Frederick or any two of them, and what they
shall order, direct or determine therein shall be binding and conclusive
to all and every person and persons therein concerned In Witness whereof
I have herunto set my hand and seal this 30th of October one thousand
