County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky being weak of body but
perfect disposing mind and memory do make and constitute
this my last will and testament to be in manner & form
following Viz First I Comend my soul to god who
will it and secondly my body to the dust to be buried in
decent christian like manner Thirdly I do hereby
give and bequeath to my faithfull servant woman Marm
her freedom and it is my wish that after my decease
she shall not be subject to any person or persons whatever
except by her own consent and it is further my wish
my mare and all my other effects except my apparel
sold to the best advantage at a Credit of Eighteen months
and that after my funeral expenses be paid the balance
come be put to interest for the whole use and benefit
of the above named Nell after she is no longer able
work and maintain herself and further I do hereby
my servant woman Marm for certain Considerations
herein after named to take good care of her mother
during her natural life - Fourthly I do give and bequeath
all my wearing apparel above excepted to my two servant
women Nell and Marm to be equally divided after my
decease by my Executor between them - Fifthly I do
for and in Consideration of my servant woman Marm
taking good care of her mother Nell that after my
the above named Marm be free from all persons and
full liberty to act for herself during her life and
all her Children that is now born or may hereafter
be free from all persons but herself whom she is to serve
until she arrive to the years of twenty one at which
time they are to go free from all persons and it is my
wish that my Executor as my representative should
as soon as possible manumit according to Law
all her Posterity and it is further my wish that
this will be recorded together with the reasonable charges of my Executor

gave and bequeath to my faithful servant woman Nell
her freedom and it is my wish that after my decease
she shall not be subject to any person or persons whatsoever
^{except} by her own consent and it is further my wish
my more and all my other effects except my apparel
sold to the best advantage at a Credit of Eighteen months
and that after my funeral expenses be paid the balance
be put to interest for the whole use and benefit
of the above named Nell after she is no longer able
work and maintain herself and further I do hereby
my servant woman Nann for certain Considerations
herein after named to take good care of her mother during
her natural life - Fourthly I do give and bequeath
all my wearing apparel above excepted to my two servant
women Nell and Nann to be equally divided after my
decease by my Executor between them - Fifthly I do give
for and in Consideration of my servant woman Nann
taking good care of her mother Nell that after my decease
the above named Nann be free from all persons and have
full Liberty to act for herself during her life and for
all her Children that is now born or may hereafter be
free from all persons but herself whom she is to serve
until she arrive to the years of twenty one at which
time they are to go free from all persons and it is my
wish that my Executor as my representative should
as soon as possible manumit according to Law all
all her Posterity and it is further my wish that
for recording this will and bequest of Emancipation
together with the reasonable Charges of my Executor
shall be paid by the above named Nann and it is
also my wish that whatever may remain of my
estate after the decease of Nell (which is by this will
bequeathed to the use and benefit of the said Nell) may
be paid to the above named Nann - Sixthly I do hereby
appoint constitute and authorize my

to put into operation this my last will & Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this twenty second day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & two signed sealed & delivered in presence of Blair Penn James Blair, James Moore, Rachel Moore,
At a County Court held for Jefferson County at the Court house on Louisville on the 10 day of May 1873 The within instrument of writing purporting to be the last will & Testament of Blair Penn was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of James Moore and Rachel Moore and ordered to be recorded Test Ward J. P. & Co. J. C.

In the name of God Amen I Samson Penn of the County of Jefferson and state of Kentucky being sick & weak in body but of sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of mankind I do hereby constitute and appoint this my last will & Testament in manner and form to wit: Item It is my desire that five hundred Dollars out of my estate be appropriated to the purpose of buying a piece of land for my wife Elizabeth Penn which said tract of land I leave to the discretion of my Executors to purchase where they may think best and on the best terms they can procure it with said sum of five hundred dollars - Item It is also my desire that my said wife Elizabeth Penn do possess all my Estate both Real and personal of every description whatever to her own proper use and benefit so long as she continues my ~~widow~~ widow. Item it is also my desire that should my said wife Eliza at any time hereafter marry that all my Estate of every description be equally divided between my four children (Wm, Richard, Sally & Robert) to them & their heirs forever - Item it is also my desire that as soon as my wife is now in a state of pregnancy be born offspring be born said
