I David Hawkins of the County of Jefferson and State of Virginia being weak of body but sound of Memory, blest be god for it, do this fifth day of August One thousand seven hundred and Eighty six. make and Publish this my last Will and Testament in manner Following, that to say, I give and bequeath to my son John. and my Daughters Latharine, Sarah, Elener Ann and Mary, the sum of Twenty Shillings each to be paid in twelve Months after the Date hereof. I give and bequeath to my son David, a Rifle Gun which is now called his I give and bequeath to my sons, William, Thomas, Henry, The Land and Tenement Whercon I now live in the County State above mentioned to be equally Divided amongst them Thomas shall have that part that lies next the Ferry with the ferry Boat to them their heirs or Assigns forever. I give and bequeath unto my wife Ann the House called the new House during her Natural life. My sons William, Thomas, and Henry, shall pay her every year during her Natural life Fifty Bushels of Corn or two hundred Pound of Good Merchantable Flour or the value of both and that to be paid yearly

without fraud or deceit and likewise her share of my
Stock the bay Mare, an Eight Gallon Kettle, the Linen of
Pots with y^e Dutch Oven, the Pewter, Knives & Forks
which she and Rebecca claims shall be theirs. with the Bed and
bedding that she Commonly lies on four Chairs. and after her
I give and devise the same Goods & Chattels to my daughter Rebecca
I give and bequeath to my sons William, Thomas, Henry and
Daughter Rebecca all my Stock of Horses Mares Little things together
with all Debts that is owing to me whether Bonds, notes
Book debts, with the farming utensils, and the Whip
such Articles of Household furniture as I have not bequeathed
my wife Alice with the broad Axe, foot Adge Gypsels
& Augers, to them their heirs or assigns for ever after paying
all Just Debts that may be proved against me.

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And I make and Ordain my Wife Alice and son John
Executors of this my Will. in trust for the intents and Purposes
this my Will Contained. In witness whereof I the said
Hawkins have to this my last Will and Testament set my
Hand Affixed My Seal the day Year above Mentioned.
