And I hereby appoint James Houston of Bourbon County and State aforesaid and Lawrence Clore of Jefferson County and State aforesaid my sole Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and nineteen.
