furniture on which I lie, which I give to my daughter Fenton

Provided she is now alive and will take it home for her own use
And my other bed, which I give to my Grand Son Miles H. Tuley

Lastly. I leave it as my last and dying request, that my friend
Thomas Elliott act as Executor of this my will
