1st First - I do devise that all my interest of an undivided part of my ~~plushes~~ (John Funks dec^d) Estate shall be sold to settle and pay all my just debts and the balance if any to be allotted as is hereinafter devised.

2^d All the balance of my property and money after discharging my debts as is stated above, both real and personal shall be applied to the benefit of my beloved wife and children as follows. My beloved wife Mary is to have the whole and sole use of said balance of my property if any (excepting as is hereafter devised) during her widowhood and to educate, board and cloath my children in a decent manner out of the proceeds thereof.

3^d But if my beloved wife Mary should ever marry after my death then and in that case all the property both real and personal remaining in her hands (except her lawful right) shall be ~~risted~~ from her and be vested in the hands of my brother in law Nathan Taylor, out of which he is to educate, board and cloath my children in a decent manner and as they become of lawful age, he is to distribute to them their equal portions as I shall devise to them in this my last will and testament.

4th I do devise to my beloved step daughter Rebecca McRichie (daughter of my beloved wife Mary and to my beloved daughters Julia Susan, Eliza Symperance and Gerracy Luisa and to my sons Thompson Taylor and Joseph Perry an equal portion of all my estate both real and personal except to my son Joseph Perry to whom I do devise by this my last will

I do devise to my beloved step daughter Rebecca M. Archibald daughter of my beloved wife Mary and to my beloved daughter Julia Susan, Eliza Symperance and Gerracy Luisa and to my sons Thompson Taylor and Joseph Perry an equal portion of all my estate both real and personal except to my son Joseph Perry to whom I do devise by this my last will and testament the sum of one hundred dollars more than his equal portion with the rest of my children which sum is to be appropriated to the completion of his Education over and above the Education he will receive from the first provisions of this my will -

5th I do devise that my brother in law Nathan Taylor now of Harrison County State of Indiana and my beloved wife Mary be appointed Executor and Executrix to this my last will and testament -

6th I do devise that my brother in law Nathan Taylor shall sell or cause to be sold any property belonging to my estate whenever he may deem it necessary and expedient for the use and benefit of my family for testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Sixth day of October Eighteen hundred and nineteen

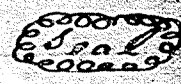
