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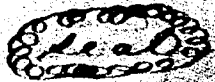
In the name of the Father, Amen

Secondly, I do hereby give and devise to my Nephew William Gordon son of my sister Catharine Gordon of Frederickburg Virginia in Trust for the sole use, benefit and behoof of my said sister and in the event of her death, then for the use and benefit of her children, all my estate consisting of money and debts due me and my watches and any and every other species of property which I may be possessed of at my death, and which shall be paid over and delivered to the said William Gordon to be held by him in Trust as herein declared, by my Executors hereafter named. The said money and property to be by said William Gordon paid and delivered over to said Catharine Gordon when and as soon as she shall if living require it, And in the event of her death to be paid & delivered in equal portions to her children or such of them as shall be alive at her death. And if any of her said children shall be dead leaving issue, such issue shall take the share and portion his or her parent would be entitled to if living.

Thirdly, I direct that no inventory or appraisement of my estate
be made or returned by my executor to the County Court.
And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my friend William
Hart executor of this my last will and testament hereby

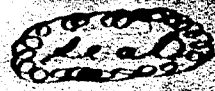
