 in manner and form following, I amprimis I have lent to John Churchill
 who married my Daughter Elizabeth Churchill in the year One thousand
 seven hundred and eighty, Four Negroes Elias Betsy and his Children
 and their Increase so long as the afore^d Donning and Elizabeth live
 and after their Deaths to their Children, but should they never have
 any Children, then they are to return to my family but as the afore^d Donning
 and Elizabeth his wife left one Child named John Donning
 it is my will and Desire that the aforesaid Negroes shall remain
 the property of my Grand Son John Donning after the Death of John
 Donning his Father forever. Item I give to my Son John Churchill
 all my Land which lies between Linn's Pond and the Fishing Pond I have
 given him half the Land which I now hold in the County of Jefferson
 called Masons opposite to the Pond and the Negroes which I have
 already given by the names of David Alwazuk Wonah and
 others forever, I have given to my Son Henry Churchill Spence his
 bloc Dicks and Jenny besides One thousand acres of Land in the
 of Fayette on the waters of Elk horn and Cedar Creek forever, I have
 given to my Son Armistead Churchill, Wm. Charles, Phoebe
 and Mary besides One thousand acres of Land in the County of
 on the waters of Elk horn and Cedar Creek forever, Item, I give to
 Daughter Mary Churchill when ever she may marry Ross Amy Spence
 and little Kate forever, Item I give to my Son Samuel Churchill
 Sharper Jenny Ben and Leliger and the Land I live on after the
 death of my Mother forever but the said Samuel Churchill is not to have
 Negroes in his possession until he comes of age or marries
 (excepted out of what they make) Item I give to my
 Son John Churchill
