last will and testament
First I give and bequeath to my wife Ann all and every of my
Slaves, all my household and kitchen furniture all my stock of
horses mule cattle sheep and hogs all my waggon and especially my
farming utensils all my corn oats hay or in cribbs shocks and grain
on the farm on which I reside and my carriage and harness to her and to
her heirs forever to be disposed of as she may think proper.
Second I give and bequeath to my wife Ann the farm on which I
now do live and purchased of Benjamin Symonds or have bargained
him for being a part of the survey on which I live during her life and
all the wood land of said tract of land to be cleared and put in cul-
tivation as the timber may be used for fencing and fuel.
Third The residue of my estate, real personal or mixed I wish and
will to be equally divided between my children Sarah, Rebecca,
Mary, Eleanor, Ann, Jonathan and Elizabeth, but no division
to be made between my children until some one of them shall
be arrived at the age of twenty one years.
Fourth So much of the rents and profits of my estate as may
be necessary, I wish applied to the education and support of my
children, and if that should be insufficient, the deficiency to
be paid out of the personal estate devised to them.
Fifth My will and intention is that no part of the estate
devised to my wife in fee or for life is to be charged with any
debts or liabilities of the last testator or his wife.

First. I leave my wife Charity one negro girl Jenny during
life time, or if she should think it best, she shall have the right
to sell her and dispose of the money as she may think best.
Also one hundred dollars so soon as it is collected on bonds
due me; but should she not sell the negro girl during her
life time, After her death she is to be sold and the money
equally divided amongst all my children, except George
he is to have no more, but one dollar, as I believe he has
his full proportional part of my estate.

Secondly. I bequeath unto my four daughters Mary Webb
Peggy Beck, Susan Shaffer and Polly Hoben all the notes
I hold against Henry, Isaac and Charity Gentry late
Charity Blousen to be equally divided amongst the above
named four daughters. After Peggy Beck, Susan Shaffer
and Polly Hoben first drawing seventy five dollars
each to make them equal with Mary Webb, money paid
her. And all the balance of my property to equally divide
amongst all my children notes, bonds and every
thing I possess, except as above excepted my son George.
And he is to have no more. And after said division
made, each one shall have full power to collect his
part of the notes and bonds.
