Item I Will bequeath to my Sister's Son James
my Jr my Silver Watch & my Gold Brooch
Item I desire that my Horse may be sold and
my just Debts may be paid out of the amount
Sale - If insufficient the balance to be

the surplus to be paid my Brother John Walls
And as to ^{all} the rest & residue of my personal Estate
I will & bequeath that my Brother John shall be
entitled to it

Item Whereas I purchased of Dr. Vaughan
two Hundred Acres of Land on Gallen's Creek, I will
& devise the same Land to my Bro John His Heirs
& assigns for ever

Item I do hereby appoint Evan
Williams & John Porter to be my Executors And
I do hereby ~~revoke all other~~ Wills and Testaments
by me heretofore made & do declare this to be my
last Will & Testament only In Witness whereof
I have hereto set my hand & seal April 3^d 1799
