I Jenkins Phillips of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky do make, constitute and ordain this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made

I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Phillips Sixteen and sixteen acres and two thirds of an acre of land lying in Jefferson County, it being the land whereon the said Thomas Phillips formerly lived to him and his heirs forever.

I also give to the said Thomas Phillips one lot of ground in the town of Louisville adjoining the public square and described and known on the plan or map of said town by number 178. It being the lot whereon a man by the name of Kelly now resides to him and his heirs forever. I likewise give to my said son Thomas Phillips the tract of land whereon I now live which I suppose to contain three hundred acres be the said more or less, by his paying to his brothers and sisters the sum of five thousand five hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever; but it is now to be clearly and perfectly understood that the said five thousand five hundred dollars is to be paid in three equal and annual instalments

I also give to my said son Thomas Phillips the following to wit: Antwine, Tom, Priscilla and her four children, by name Stephen, Isaac, Val and Ben, them and their future increase to him and his heirs forever.

I bequeath to my son Richard Phillips this whole of the South Eastern part of the

man by the name of Kelly now resides to him and his heirs forever.
I likewise give to my said son Thomas Phillips the tract of land where
I now live which I suppose to contain three hundred acres be the same
more or less, by his paying to his brothers and sisters the sum of five
thousand five hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever; but it
is now to be clearly and perfectly understood that the said five
thousand five hundred dollars is to be paid in three equal and equal
instalments

I also give to my said son Thomas Phillips the following negro
to wit: Antwine, Genl. Priscilla and her four children, by name Stephen,
Israel, Val and Ben, them and their future increase to him and his
heirs forever

I also give and bequeath to my son Richard Phillips the whole of
land lying on the Northeastwardly side of the South fork of
Creek and adjoining the lands of David L. Ward, General Comdr.
Clarks heirs and the land wherein William Oldham at present
resides, which I suppose to contain two hundred and fifty acres
the same more or less, it being the land wherein my son Thomas
Phillips formerly lived and which said land is now owned by
a part of the negroes belonging to my son Richard Phillips
and his heirs forever. I also give to my said son Richard Phillips
two hundred acres of land lying in the township of
