to the remaining three acres and a half of said lot

✓ lot, after my wife's death, I devise the same to my sons Joseph and
Jeremiah Williams their heirs and assigns forever, to which with the
house and other improvements so to be equally divided between them.
2nd I devise to my daughter Patsy Williams one hundred dollars
in money and the black mare.

3rd I devise to my daughter Nancy Williams one hundred dollars in money.
4th I do also devise to my daughter Eliza Williams one hundred
dollars in money -

5th I devise to my daughter Amelia Williams one hundred dollars
in money - The foregoing legacies to be paid when the respective chil-
dren come of age or shall be married -

6th I devise that my son Washington shall be maintained out of
my estate during his life by my wife and children.

✓ 7th My waggon and team of fine horses, gear &c I devise to my wife and
son Joseph Williams in equal shares.

✓ 8th I devise to my daughter Phoebe Baxter ten dollars in full of her
share of my estate.

✓ 9th I devise ten dollars to my son John Williams in full of his
share of my estate.

✓ 10th I leave fifty dollars to my daughter Catherine Perkins in full
of her share of my estate -

✓ 11th I devise my other waggon and team to my son Jeremiah and my
wife in equal shares -

✓ 12th I devise and bequeath to my beloved wife all my household fur-
niture, farming stock, cattle, sheep, hogs and my money on hand and
outstanding debts to her now use and for the support of my children.

I do devise and bequeath to my beloved wife all my household furniture, farming stock, cattle, sheep, hogs and my money on hand and outstanding debts to her own use and for the support of my children and payment of the legacies before bequeathed, the growing crop to be appropriated for the use of my family. And I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Martha Williams my sole Executrix of this my last will and testament.
