County of Shippingport and it may be to the interest of my children
after my death that they should not be immediately divided among
them, but that they should be placed under the direction of some
person qualified to manage them so as to make them profitable
It is my will and desire and I do hereby authorize and empower
my brother Louis Anastasius Sarascen to take the supreme control
of them as well as all the rest of my estate, both real and personal
and to make all such contracts as he may deem necessary or proper
And I do moreover authorize and empower him, giving him full
ample and complete powers to sell or otherwise dispose of any part
of my real and personal estate as he or any think necessary
proper for the purposes aforesaid as well as for the maintenance
education and support of my children.

having due regard to their necessities and I do not
have been advanced to any one of the children
make the final division required and
them. It is my will and desire that as my children shall
attain the age of twenty five years or shall marry, the said
said brother shall give to each child such portion of my estate as
may deem just and right, having due regard to the maintenance
education and support of the other children and his own support
them. If all my said children shall die without lawful issue
my said brother, then and in that case I give and devise the whole
of my estate both real and personal to him and to his heirs and
assigns forever.

Item. It is my will and desire and I do hereby direct that
my said brother shall take upon himself the burden and responsibility
of this my last will and testament that he shall not be required
by the Court to give any security whatever for the faithful
performance of the duties herein and before mentioned and I do moreover
direct that no inventory and appraisement of my personal estate shall
be made, as I have entire confidence in the ability, justice, integrity
and friendly disposition of my said brother towards my children.
Lastly, I nominate, constitute and appoint my said brother
Anastasio Tarascon Executor of this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all other wills or wills heretofore by me made.
